Ever lose your snorkel and mask while snorkeling or SCUBA diving? Instead of watching them sink into the depths of the ocean to settle on the sea bed, possibly damaging or killing coral and marine life, now watch them float on the surface with your new SNORKELBUOY®!



SNORKELBUOY® is a unique snorkel float suitable for both saltwater and freshwater use. Your mask will float too, as long as your mask is securely attached to your snorkel with a strong snorkel-keeper (not included). The bright color and design (red, with a white diagonal stripe, similar to the “Diver Down” flag) makes the SNORKELBUOY® easy to see as it floats. Dive tested and approved to 100 feet by a Master Scuba Diver, SNORKELBUOY® does not affect the diver’s buoyancy.

SNORKELBUOY® is NOT a safety device, although the appearance of a floating mask and snorkel would certainly alert nearby people that someone had lost their mask and snorkel and might be in trouble. GREAT for children or adults who might accidentally drop their masks and snorkels in the water, GREAT for dive shops where masks and snorkels are rented out on a daily basis – this will assure that they get them back – GREAT for snorkelers/divers who are investing in good equipment and don’t want to lose it, GREAT for underwater photographers to use as buoyancy foam on their heavy underwater cameras, GREAT for dive/snorkel charters where they have a limited number of masks and snorkels on board – this way nobody loses theirs! Can also be used as a dive reel float, or reef marker buoy.

SNORKELBUOY® is easy to install – By pushing and twisting, insert the top of your snorkel into and through the Snorkelbuoy®, or remove your snorkel mouthpiece and insert into the Snorkelbuoy®, making sure you firmly reinstall the mouthpiece. The correct placement is when there is about 2 – 3 inches of snorkel protruding from the top of the Snorkelbuoy®. It is designed to be a very tight fit. A small dab of silicone grease inside the shaft may make it easier to install. Snorkelbuoy®! Every snorkel should have one!
